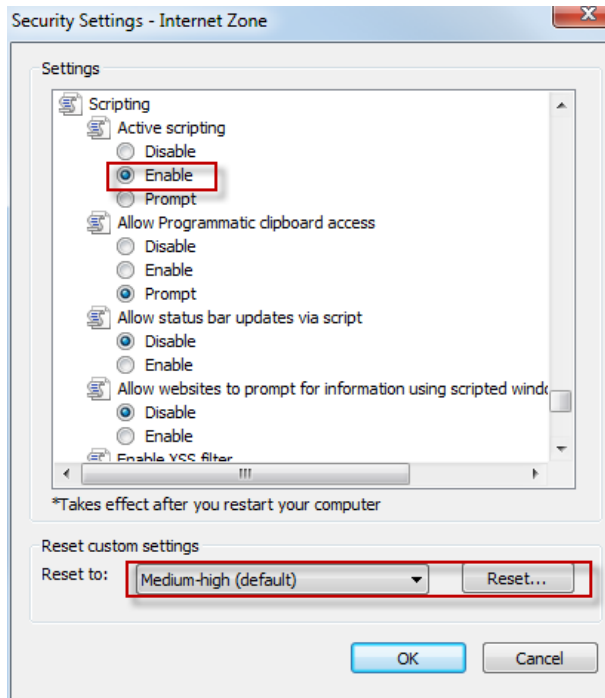
Go To: Advance Tab under Security, Check for Signatures on download program and click Ok.



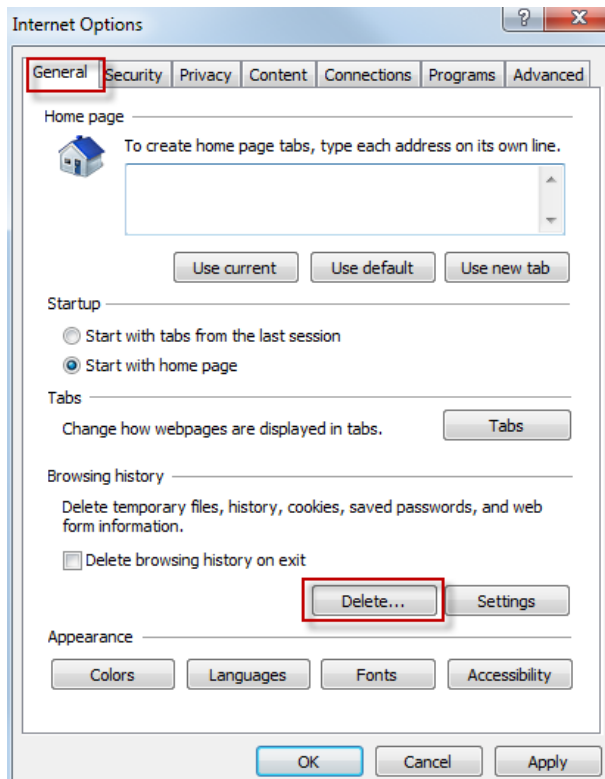
Go To: Security tab click Custom level.



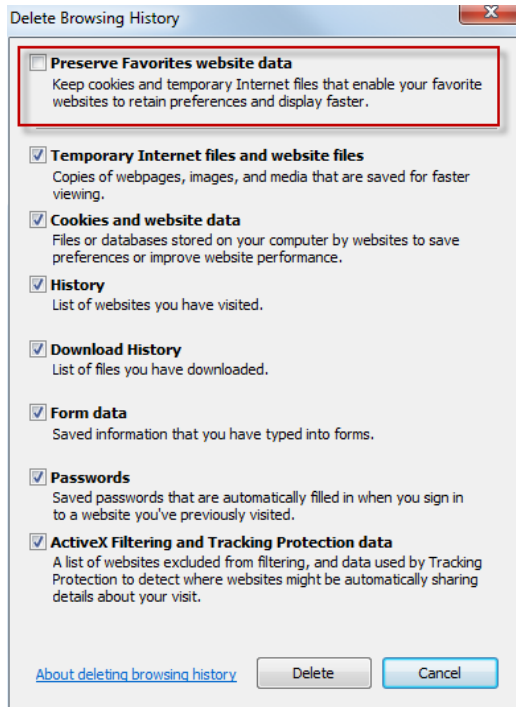
Scroll To: Scripting and Set Active Scripting to Enable, Under Reset custom Settings select Medium-High and click Reset. Then, click Ok.



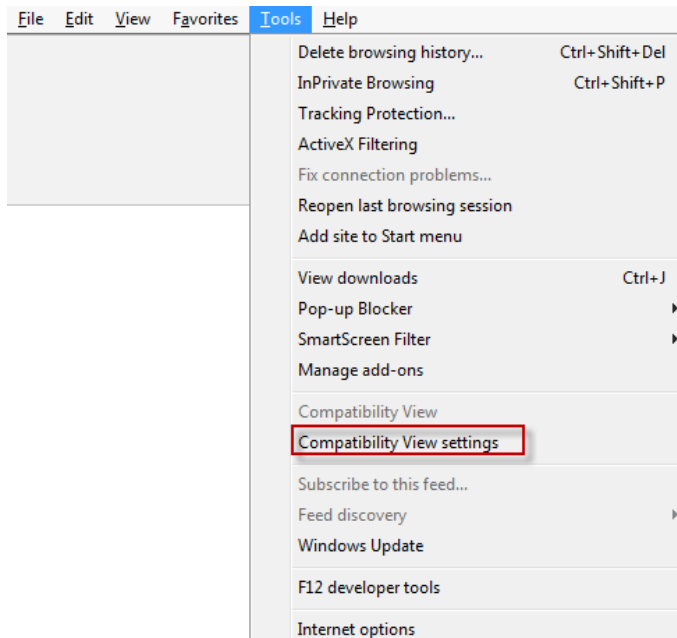
Go To: General tab and Under Browsing History click Delete.



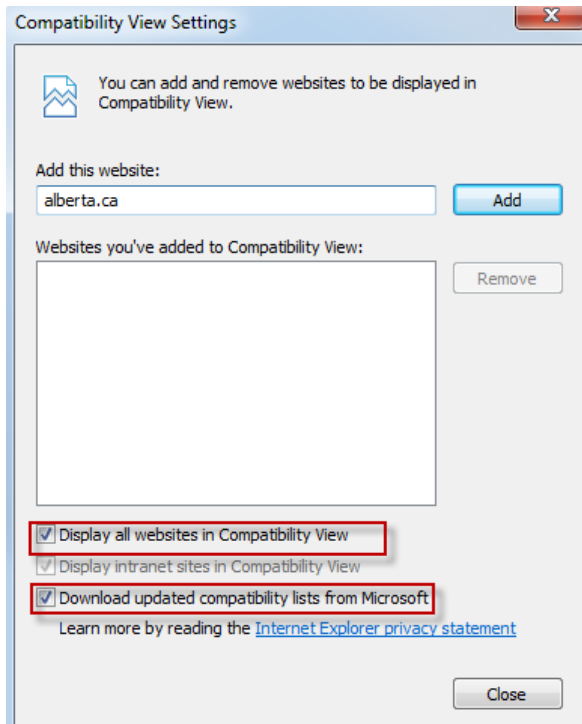
Uncheck Preserve Favorites website data and click Delete.



Go To: Tools > Compatibility view setting.



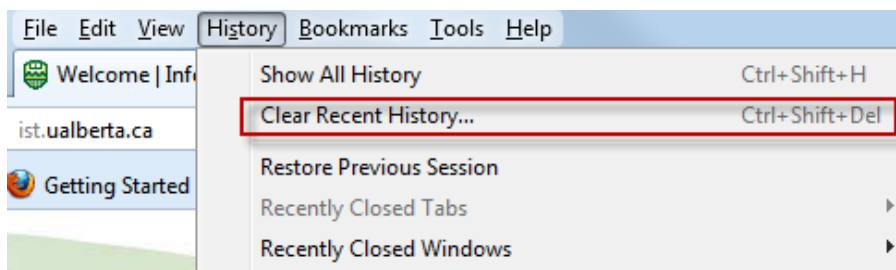
Check: Display all website in Compatibility View and Download Updated compatibility lists for Microsoft.



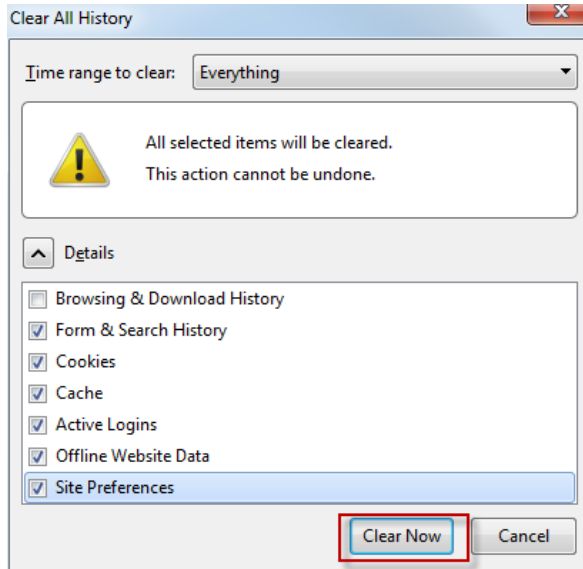
Mozilla Firefox (42, 38 ESR) browser settings for PeopleTools 8.5x

Go To: History > Clear Recent History.



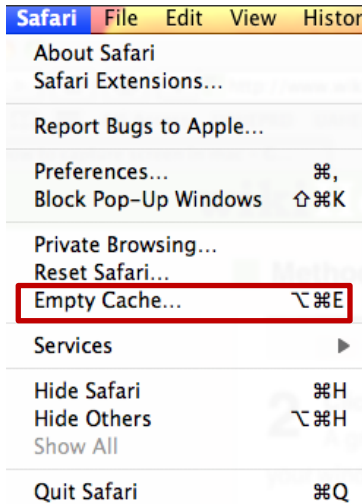
Select the below list as shown and click Clear Now.



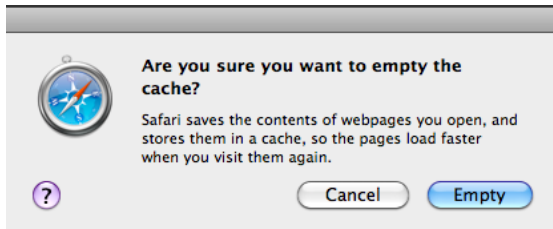
Safari browser settings for PeopleTools V8.5x – MAC Machine

Please ensure the following options are set in Safari before signing on to PeopleSoft.

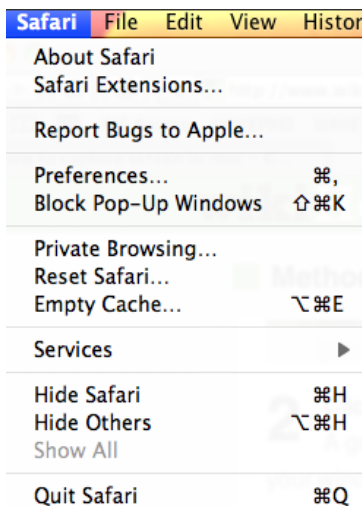
Got To: Safari and click on Empty Cache.



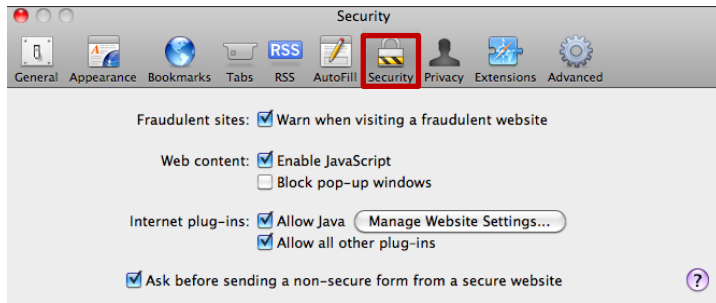
Click on Empty.



Go To: Safari and click Preferences.



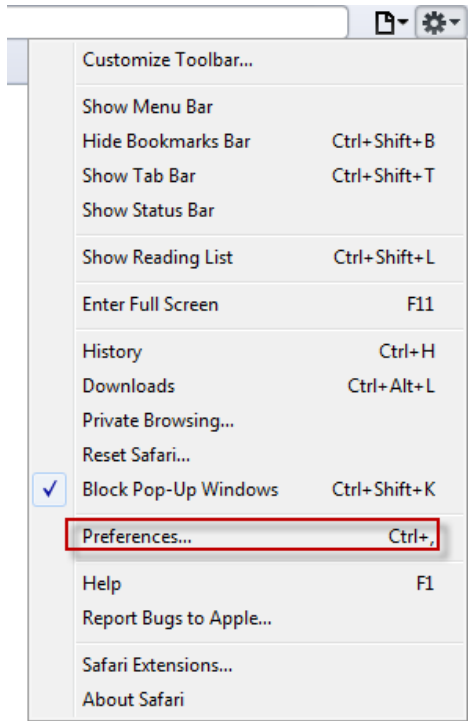
Select the security tab and Check the enable JavaScript checkbox.



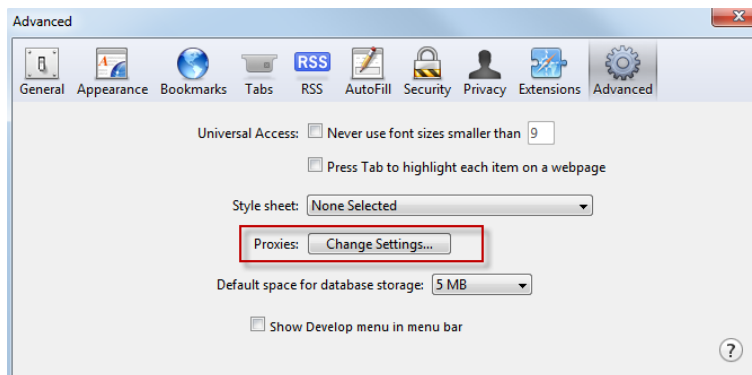
Safari browser settings for PeopleTools V8.5x – MAC Machine

Please ensure the following options are set in Safari before signing on to PeopleSoft.

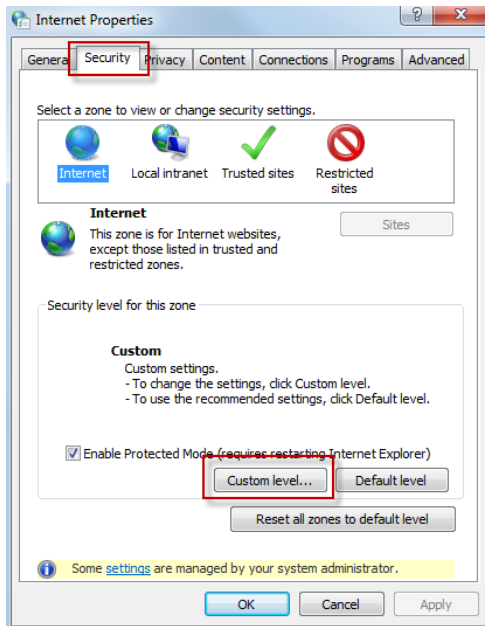
Go To: Setting (Gear) and click Preference.



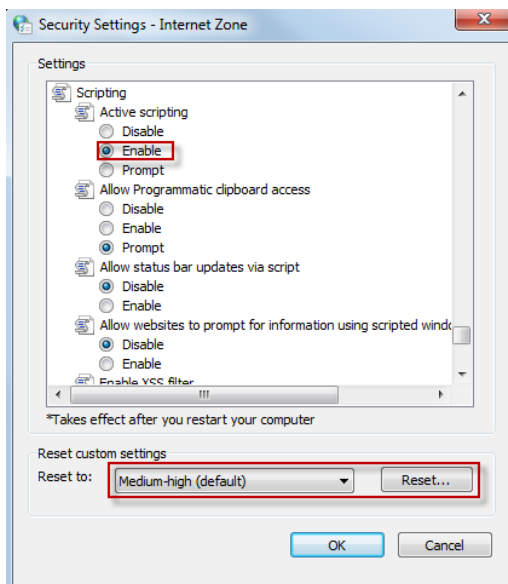
Go To: Advance and click Change Setting.



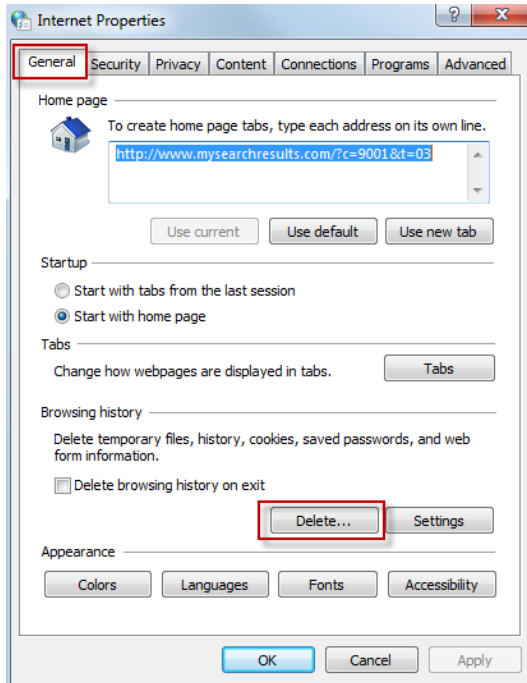
Go To: Security tab and click Custom level.
